

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CARPE DIEM

Literary events

EVENT ONE: INTER CLASS QUIZ COMPETITION

- Two to three people in one team
- Each question will carry one mark
- Bonus points round will carry two marks for each question
- Points to be calculated at the end to decide a winning team
- The quizmaster's decision will be final regarding any of the question

EVENT TWO: DEBATE COMPETITION

- Individual event
- 120 seconds for individual speaking time
- 90 seconds for rebuttal
- For and against to be decide through ballot system
- Participants are requested to attack the opinions, not the people. Any personal attacks against any other speaker shall not be tolerated. The speaker will be marked negatively in such a case.

EVENT THREE: INTER CLASS SLAM POETRY COMPETITION

- 5 + 2 minutes awarded to each participant
- English, as a medium of poetry is preferable
- If the participant wishes to recite a poetry in a regional language, they must provide a hard copy of the translation to the Literary Committee two days prior to the event
- No use of vulgar words. No personal attacks allowed. If any of the aforementioned are not adhered to, the participants will be disqualified

EVENT FOUR: ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

- Online submissions to be done before 1 pm and to be sent to arundhati.sural@arts.christuniversity.in
- Word limit is restricted to 500 words. Beyond a word limit of 550 words, there will be negative marking.
- Only 20% plagiarism allowed
- If any participants wants to submit a hard copy, they must submit it in person to Arundhati Sural, IIIEPS, block 1, before 2 pm.

Cultural Events

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- Each person from the class must compulsorily participate in at least one event
- The events are categorized into dance, music and theatre, each lasting up to one hour
- The last date for registration is 22nd June, 2017.

EVENT ONE: CONTEMPORARY DANCE

- The team must consist of 4 to 8 members
- Time duration of each dance must be 4 to 5 minutes
- There must compulsorily be a fusion of songs
- Songs can be of any language
- Any kind of obscenity in songs and vulgarity in dance is prohibited
- Use of props is allowed

EVENT TWO: INDIAN MUSIC

- The team must consist of 4 to 8 members
- Time limit is 4+1 minute
- A medley of songs are allowed.
- All Indian languages are permitted
- Use of instruments are necessary. Instruments must be brought by the team members

EVENT THREE: WESTERN MUSIC

- The team must consist of 4 to 8 members
- Time limit is 4+1 minute
- Songs should be of English band, artist or album. Fusion of two or more songs are allowed
- Use of instruments is necessary. Instruments need to be brought by the team members

EVENT FOUR: MIME

- The team must consist of 4 to 6 members
- Time limit is 4+1 minute
- No act shall contain any offensive or obscene acts or gestures
- The act should not contain any dialogue or use of props. Use of music is permitted

EVENT FIVE: SKIT

- The team should consist of 5-10 members
- The time limit is 9+1 minute
- The theme, dialogue and presentation of skit should not be vulgar
- Required props and costumes need to be arranged by the participating team
